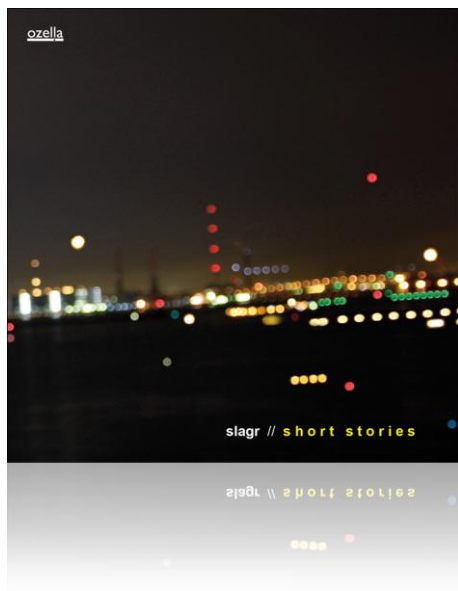


## The Sound Of Time
