






Karl Seglem





This implied combining all of his different influences, from his jazz roots to his interest in contemporary electronics.

Bass Detector is all about essence, risk, breaks with routine and complete freedom. Through this Slagr create their own genre, combining the folk tradition of Norway with contemporary classical music and ambient.






